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A cost estimate establishes the base line of the project cost at different stages of development of the project. ... A typical process for developing a cost estimate using one of these systems would include: ... an item of \$300,000 for site preparation is not typical for similar plants.

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A project budget is a detailed, time-phased estimate of all resource costs for your project. You typically develop a budget in stages — from an initial rough estimate to a detailed estimate to a completed, approved project budget. On occasion, you may even revise your approved budget while your project is in progress.

For example, to undertake a parametric analysis (a process used to estimate project costs on a per unit basis, subject to the specific requirements of a project), cost estimators will often use a computer database containing information on costs and conditions of many other similar projects and geographic locations.

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(viii) Cost estimate. Estimates of base (civil works) cost must be calculated using unit rates judged to be applicable for the region of the project site and major quantities of each item shall be calculated from the drawings in just sufficient detail to serve the needs of proper estimating.
